

## C I R C U L A R

It has brought to the notice by the Directorate of Health Services, Panaji-Goa, that most of the boats are left uncovered at Dona paula jetty, Hawaii Beach & Aivao, thereby collecting rain water in these boats during monsoon, which cause nuisance under Section 37 of Goa Public Health Act, and leading to potential source of mosquito breeding and public nuisance and impending source of health hazards.

Therefore, all owners/masters of the barges, shipyards/drydocks, passenger launches, ferry boats, tindels of fishing trawlers of the mechanized and non mechanized crafts including tourists boats plying in the inland waters are directed to ensure that all the boats are properly covered and there will be no stagnation of water in the boats.

Violation of the above will be viewed seriously.
